### EVENT DESCRIPTIONS:

**Steel Bridge** - An event that challenges students to design, fabricate, and construct a 20 feet bridge made entirely of steel.

**Seismic Design** - A developer wants to build a new multi-million condo in Downtown San Diego but has worries of the seismic activities that will take place. Design teams must design a building that will withstand the "Big One."

**Technical Paper** - Annual event that challenges students to write an essay concerning ethics in engineering.

**Environmental Design** - Teams compete to devise a system to filter and identify constituents that are in water.

**Concrete Frisbee** - In this event, students will design and construct a Frisbee made of concrete. It will test the students' abilities to become creative as they will need to design a durable and practical Frisbee.

**Concrete Bowling** - Who ever thought that what we would use concrete for. In this event students are challenge to make a strong and durable bowling ball made of concrete.

**Transportation Event** - A new event this year. Teams are challenged to create a solution to a transportation problem. They will create a formal preliminary report, create a solution, and present their solution to a panel of judges during the conference.

**Surveying** - Student teams use surveying equipment to make accurate measurements.

**Quiz Bowl** - Teams of 5 are quizzed on a multitude of questions ranging from general engineering and general science subjects (Freshmen Required!).

**Impromptu** - Student Team's engineering skills are put under pressure as they are given a task and have to come up with a solution in only a few hours.

**Basketball** - Team event to allow engineering students to show off their athletic skills. Who's got game?

**Volleyball** - Sporting event to promote good teamwork, good sportsmanship, and athletic abilities.

**Wiffleball** - A new sporting event to the region. This event is tons of fun!
